Solana Beach Board of Education Member Tanya Koshy to Resign

Effective June 2025



SOLANA BEACH, CA (April 21, 2025) — The Solana Beach School District (SBSD) announces that Board Member Tanya Koshy will resign from her position on the Board of Education, with her final meeting on June 12, 2025. Ms. Koshy was elected to the Board in November 2024 and represents Trustee Area #5.

"Serving on the SBSD Board of Education has been a true honor," said Koshy. "This community means so much to me, which makes it especially difficult to step down as I relocate to care for my father, who is terminally ill. I'm grateful to have worked alongside such

dedicated teachers, staff, and community members in service of our incredible students."

Her deep care for students and families has been evident in every conversation and decision she has been part of. While we are saddened by her departure, we are grateful for her service and send our heartfelt support during this personal time."
