Solana Beach School District Board of Education Announces Application, Appointment Process, and Timeline for Board Vacancy

SOLANA BEACH, CA (April 25, 2025)—The [Solana Beach School District](#) (SBSD) Board of Education announces the appointment process and timeline for its seat vacancy, following Board Member Tanya Koshy's resignation announcement, effective June 30, 2025. The Board is required to fill the vacancy within a 60-day time limit. Board members voted at the April 24 special meeting to adopt an appointment process and timeline to fill the vacancy.

May 7, 2025	Candidate information meeting held in the District Office Board Room at 5:30 p.m.
May 30, 2025	Application packets must be received by US mail, email, or hand-delivery to the Superintendent's Office by noon.
June 6, 2025	Eligible candidates are notified of an interview.
June 17, 2025	Special Board Meeting <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Candidate interviews• Vote on appointment
June 18, 2025	Regular Board Meeting <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Administration of Oath of Office

Ms. Koshy announced her resignation on April 21, 2025, basing her decision on her desire to relocate to care for her ailing father which does not allow her to continue serving on the Board of Education. The Board, Superintendent Jennifer Burks, and staff members will honor Ms. Koshy at the June 12, 2025, regularly scheduled Board meeting.
